

If you do not wish to appear on the screen during the distribution of communion you are asked to sit on the right of the church.

The Paradox of Abundance

We pray for our Government, that their ability to support pregnant women would increase and that they would anchor themselves on the desire to protect all human life from conception to natural death. Amen.


New Readers Rota

And finally:- Following the announcement about the return of the Sunday Obligation, on last weekend's newsletter, several people have asked questions about the live-streaming of the Parish Masses. Since March 2020 the 'live-streaming' of our Masses has been an invaluable spiritual asset to those who cannot attend Mass, and 'cannot attend' is the important phrase in this sentence. With the return of the obligation there is also the acknowledgement that there are those who, for a legitimate reason, cannot fulfil the Sunday Obligation. There are also those who, having attended Mass on a Sunday either here or in another Parish, like the fact that they can either access the Mass video at a later time. There are also those who join in with the weekday Masses via the 'live-stream' – for which there is no obligation to attend. I would therefore like to assure you that not only is the 'Live-streaming of the Masses' going to continue! We are in the process of having a permanent camera, one which will be live 24hrs a day, installed in the church to further improve this provision for the housebound and those who chose to use this facility in accordance with the return of the Sunday Obligation.
