

And finally:- This week the new Live-stream camera was fitted in the church. With the new camera installed there are changes to the way in which you access the live-streaming of the services held here at St. Mary of the Angels. Mass, and all other services will no longer be live-streamed on the parish Facebook Page, instead there is a dedicated web page that is accessed through the homepage of the Parish Website. The new camera is 'live' 24hrs a day, so it is now possible to make a 'virtual visit' to the church to pray before the Blessed Sacrament at any time. This change also means that all services, not only Mass, are now available via our live-stream. For those who like to watch the pre-recorded Masses at a time other than when they are live, panic not! Once the Mass has ended, and I have learnt how to do it, the recording will then be uploaded to the Facebook Page and remain there like all of the other Masses which are still available going back to June 2020.
