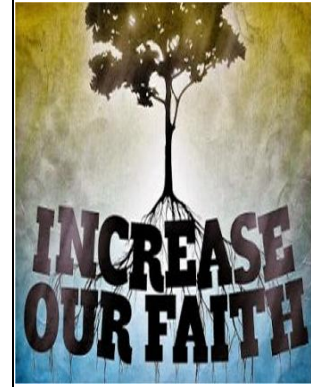

And finally:- "If you build it, he will come" – a line taken from the 1989 movie Field of Dreams – is perhaps one of the most iconic lines in movie history. In the movie the central character perseveres, against opposition from family and friends, with his dream. Despite the odds being stacked against him the movie ends with the fulfilment of his dream, and the family farm is saved from financial ruin. At the beginning of the synodal process Pope Francis invited every Catholic Christian to "dare to dream". To rediscover that living faith which is the source of our hope, allowing us to see beyond present struggles to the fulfilment of God's promises. To become re-energised in our commitment to spread the Good News, as we continue to build up the Kingdom of God here on earth.
