And finally:- On Wednesday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. Whilst, during the course of the year we celebrate the day on which all of the four Major Basilicas were dedicate, only St. John Lateran is kept as a solemnity, a Feast of the Lord. Why you may ask? Contrary to popular belief St. Peter's in the Vatican is not the seat of the Bishop of Rome, it is not the Cathedral Church of the City, nor is it the focal point of the unity of the Church – St. John Lateran is. Within days of the election of a new Pope, which he is by virtue of his being elected Bishop of Rome, the new Pope takes possession of his Cathedral Church, just as any newly appointed bishop does in his own diocese. We are therefore reminded this week to pray for the unity of the Church. To pray that the Pope may remain steadfast in proclaiming the faith as handed down to us by the apostles. To pray that we, following in the footsteps of the apostles, may do all that we can to build up the Body of Christ here on earth by our words and actions, so that all may encounter Christ in the Church that He loves.
