And finally:- The Gospel of this Second Sunday of Advent presents to us the figure of St. John the Baptist, who, a famous prophecy of Isaiah says, withdrew to the desert of Judaea and, with his preaching, called the people to convert so as to be ready for the coming of the Messiah, now at hand.
