And finally:- On this Sunday the Gospel according to St. Matthew recounts the birth of Jesus from St. Joseph's viewpoint. He was betrothed to Mary who, "before they came together... was found to be with child of the Holy Spirit"... St. Joseph is presented as "a just man", faithful to God's law and ready to do his will... Having given up the idea of divorcing Mary secretly, Joseph took her to himself because he then saw God's work in her with his own eyes. Although he had felt distressed, Joseph "did as the Angel of the Lord commanded him", certain that he was doing the right thing... the new man is outlined in him, who looks with trust and courage to the future. He does not follow his own plans but entrusts himself without reserve to the infinite mercy of the One who will fulfil the prophecies and open the time of salvation. (Benedict XVI)
