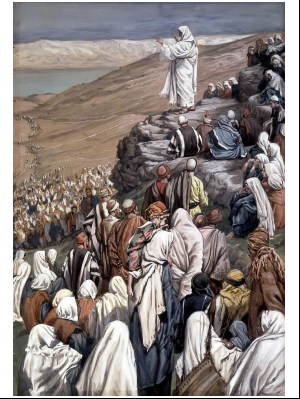

**And finally:-** During the course of this week the Christmas Nativity Scene, the crib, will be removed from the front of the church. Its removal, however, does not mark the end of our meditation on the mystery of the Lord's love revealed in the Incarnation of the Word. Here at St. Mary of the Angels we are blessed with having a perpetual reminder of the Christmas story. Across the front of the pulpit, lectern, and the altar are inscribed words taken from the Gospel according to John "The Word made flesh and dwelt amongst us". With these words we are reminded that through the reading of the Word of God, whether at home or in church, and in a substantial way in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar, Christ continues to be incarnate in the world of today. This, however, is only part of the story. The reality is that Christ continues to be present in you and in me; in every act of faith, in every act of charity, in every moment of prayer "The Word is made flesh and dwells amongst us".
