

And finally:- Over the next few Sundays, at the celebration of the 9:30am Mass, our three candidates for reception into full communion with the Catholic Church will undergo the Scrutinies. On each of these days the prayer of exorcism reflects the central message of the gospel passages of the Sunday Masses in Year A.
