And finally:- On this Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time the Prophet Zechariah encourages us to "rejoice heart and soul". Despite all that the people of Israel had to undergo, the prophet reminds them that if they trust in the Lord, He will come to them – He will be with them - and in Him they will triumph. This same image is taken up in the gospel when the Lord invites us to "shoulder [His] yoke and learn from [Him]". The 'yoke' of course is the instrument by which two are bound together in order that they may work as one. Taking upon ourselves the Lord's 'yoke' means being united to Him in all that we do, and in all that we may have to undergo in our daily lives. This 'yoke' brings to those who bear it the gifts of gentleness, humility, and the promise of resting in the love of Christ. Having this gift of faith, the knowledge that Christ is with us in all that we do, brings us comfort as we face the challenges of life, sure and certain in the knowledge that we are never alone, that the Lord bears our burdens with us.
