The main duty of the Welcomer is to ensure all visitors to the church are welcome. We want to ensure that strangers feel at home in our church. Look out particularly for any parishioner who looks as if they might be unwell and ensure that Fr. Craig is kept informed of this. As a first point of contact you are ideally placed, often seeing the same people every week, to observe changes in people.

Ensure that Hymnals and Mass Missals are handed to all that might need them but we should not automatically hand out newsletters, as many members of the parish now receive these by email. Newsletters can always be downloaded from our website. We now produce 50 copies per week where pre-pandemic we printed 200. The advantages of this are twofold; it saves the parish money on stationery but also improves our environmental footprint by not wasting paper unnecessarily.
