

And finally:-. A few weekends ago I wrote in the Newsletter to give you an update on my health and wellbeing. Sadly, since that update, things have not gone well. In the afternoon of Thursday 22nd I began to feel unwell and, following the advice of my consultant, I was taken into A&E at the Royal Stoke University Hospital. Having spent 10hrs in the Emergency Department, I was taken into the care of the hospital and booked to return to theatre the following day. On Friday 23rd I underwent a second surgical procedure which discovered a clot in my back and an infection. I then spent the next 5 days in hospital receiving very high doses of IV antibiotics before being sent back to my parents' late Tuesday afternoon. Please do not worry, I am well and my recovery is now back on track - if this kind of thing only happens to 1 in 100 people you can guarantee it would happen to me.
