And finally:-. The Gospel reading of this weekend presents us with one of the most popular, and most well know, images of the Lord – that of the Good Shepherd. In this image we see a shepherd who, rather than lording it over the flock, ruthlessly driving them onwards from the rear, has with his sheep a relationship built upon trust; a relationship which means the sheep willingly listen to his voice and follow where he leads. So powerful is the relationship between the shepherd and his sheep that we are told that he would willingly "lay down his life for [his] sheep". Over the past few weeks, and indeed still today, we are celebrating the gift of God's unconditional love for each one of us, a love that invites us into a trusting relationship with the Good Shepherd. The challenge for each one of us is to "remain in [His] love"; to renew each day our trust in Him, even when we are troubled by uncertainty and doubt, fear and anxiety, and to allow Him to be the Shepherd of our souls.
